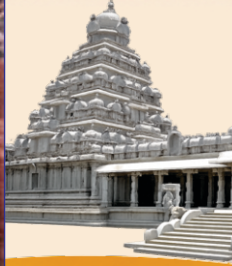


KANCHI MAHASWAMI MANIMANTAPAM - ORIKKAI

YAGASALAI MANTAPAM



Dear Devotees,

The Kanchi Mahaswami Manimantapam (the 68th Peetadhipathi of the Illustrious Sri Kanchi Kamakoti Matam) at Orikkai was built and consecrated first for the Vimanam in 2011. Subsequently, the Nandi Mantapam and Rajagopuram were built and consecration done in 2018.

The Manimantapam consists of 100 ft high Vimanam, Ardh Mantapam, Maha Mantapam with 100 pillars, a Nandi Mantapam with a huge granite Nandi weighing around 45 tons, Deepasthambam in granite about 50 ft height, a Raja Gopuram about 48 feet high, an Octagonal tank (Kulam), a Gho Shala housing 200 cows

and calves, fodder sheds, a dining hall with 150 persons seating capacity, Rooms above the dining hall in first and second floors, a Chandramouleeswarar pooja hall with all facilities, a concrete road connecting Manimantapam with the main road, granite pathway around plus staff quarters.

The SSSMM Trust runs a Veda Patasala teaching Rig Vedam and Yajur Vedam, with about 48 Vidyarthi and 4 teachers. A separate kitchen and dining hall with a capacity to seat 70 persons has been built along with separate quarters for their boarding. Daily Annadanam is also offered to the Public.

Originally, a Sapthaswara Sthambam and Avudaiyar type Kodungai and Yagasalai were contemplated to be built, but could not be carried out. Though the above works were not carried out, partial stones had been procured and were lying at Orikkai.

Recently Mahaswami appeared in the dream of a Devotee and indicated that the stones were lying at the Manimantapam. The Devotee was perplexed about the dream and it was explained that they were meant for Yagasalai and connected works. Understanding the message conveyed by Mahaswami through the devotee, it is now proposed to revive the Yagasalai Mantapam and allied works.

The Yagasalai Mantapam will contain 16 granite Pillars, well carved out, of which 4 will be for Sapthaswara Sthambham. The Sapthaswara Sthambham will have a main pillar with 7 additional small pillars.





The general view of the Yagasalai Mantapam is provided for reference. The Yagasalai Mantapam is proposed to be located in the North East corner of the Manimantapam as per Shastras.

- ✿ The current estimated cost of the Yagasalai Mantapam is around **7.0 crores.**
- ✿ **With Mahaswami's Anugraham and blessings,** the Yagasalai Mantapam is expected to be completed in **two years.**
